Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Balance of \$58,150.00. Aaron reviewed Maroon, Gold and Eagle contributions and all funds will go into the general Booster fund because Capital Campaign was turned down by School Board. Spirit Wear order needed to be covered. \$18,000 will be put into budget for team requests. We will review this in November.

Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- All Fall sports started official practice today with most team number up over last year.
- First conference meeting will be held in a week.

- All Coaching spots are filled.

Membership Chair: Meg Angevine

- Team Roster will be ready in a week and Meg will get information to Reps on who is and is not a Booster member.
- Membership numbers are way down this year but we received more money because of the tiered membership. 113 members of which 38% are freshman families. This is half of the families we had last year.
- Meg has decals to pass out at kick-off night with the rest of the merchandise for tiered members hopefully due in soon.

Team Rep Reports:

- **Cheerleading** – Thanked Boosters for pom-poms and the cheerleaders did really well both as a team and individually at their competition.
- **Girls Tennis** – Meeting this coming Monday. Looks like a strong team. 25 at practice today.
- **Football** – Numbers are up and Channel 31 was featuring them tonight.
- **Girls Swimming** – 24 participants – numbers up from last year. Dunlap has a young, strong team this year.
- **Boys Soccer** – Numbers are up.
- **X Country** – They will be able to have home meets on their course. Numbers are up. August 20th is a Run-A-Thon to raise money for the team.
- **Volleyball** – Very excited about team and coaches.
- **Boys Golf**- Good numbers today. Some cuts already made to have 6 on Varsity and 6 JV.

Allocations Committee:

- Volleyball: Approved – Partial cost of Acuspik hitting aid (\$2000) after much discussion.
- Request for Funding Form will now include number/percentage of Booster participation in the sport.

New Business:

- **Referendum/Facilities Improvement** – Pete Mangieri updated us on the progress.
 - **Soccer** – Field will be seed soon and the irrigation is done.
 - **Football** – Worked 21 days straight to get field ready to start practice. New concession stand has moisture and restrooms will be functional next week.
 - **Softball/Baseball** – Fields are done.
 - **Tennis** - Paved tennis courts, hoping to be ready by the first home game. Lights are in and there is no landscaping in contract around tennis courts.
 - **Ring Road** has been a challenge.
 - Duane's maintenance crew will work with Turf Solutions to take over after they complete their portion. May need to purchase equipment. An outdoor maintenance man has been given more hours.
- **Volunteers for Kick-off Night** – Meg will send out email for volunteers. Aaron will speak for Boosters.
- **50/50 & VIP Parking** – Our license is not current working to resolve. Need someone to head up 50/50 and VIP Parking.
- **Concessions** – need to come up with a process/rules that are fair for working events and for other teams running their own concessions. A committee will look into this.
