Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Total balance of \$48,624.37. Approximately \$5,700 still to spend on team requests. Looking into an interest bearing checking account or ways we could have the money work harder for us.

Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- Girls BB will be at ND for Regionals; beat Limestone at Limestone to take become leader in conference.
- Boys Basketball we will host our Regionals – Galesburg, Richwoods and ND. Games will be Tuesday – Dunlap & ND; Wednesday – Richwoods & Galesburg; winners play on Friday.
- Track has started and will have indoor meets in a couple of weeks.
- Baseball & Softball have both started indoor practice.
- Getting 50/50 Raffle license renewed.

- Getting updated information ready for March Social.

- Reminded everyone to bring up Booster membership at Spring Team Meetings.

#### Team Rep Reports:

- **Boys Swimming** – They were the Journal Star Conference Champs by 100 points! Undefeated in regular season dual meets; tied with Richwoods; huge Sectionals next weekend in Peoria with 16 teams.
- **Boys Basketball** – Freshman are 7-6; Sophomores around the same; Varsity 6-12 but has lost a lot of really close games. Play ND in Regionals.
- **Girls Basketball** – Varsity 10-4. Playing really well.
- **Girls Soccer** – Starting practice and would like lines painted on the field at Wilder-Waite as soon as the snow is gone and would like a POD for equipment to be kept on site. Mr. Peterson will take care of both items.
- **Cheerleading** – has try-outs in April. There will be Mascot try-outs at the same time. Right now Kiera Brown is in the Eagle costume and doing a great job.

#### Allocations Committee:

- Lisa had check for Parent Club for our half of Eagle Mascot costume – looks really nice – Screech is the new name for the Eagle Mascot.
- Baseball requested \$280 for new catcher equipment. Vote was to approve. (Keenan/Plantamura)
- Fishing Team putting together a request.

#### New Business:

- **Social** – Spring Social will be THURSDAY, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 in the DHS Commons. Lisa Mathes will design and have postcards sent out. Items on the Agenda for the meeting will be the Facilities Upgrades; Preferred Parking; Team Requests and what we have purchased in the last year; Tiered Membership; Coaches will be there. Barrack's will provide a cheesecake bar. **Tiered Membership** – Pete and Aaron put together a tiered membership plan that will allow members and businesses to really support Dunlap athletics in a big way and allow us to do some of the bigger projects for athletics that are not in the school or facilities improvement budget. There was discussion about the amounts but it was decided to go with this plan because if we lower the amounts we will not get responses or support that is planned for this type of giving. Talk about a plaque with large donor names on it was discussed. Names for the levels were discussed with Maroon (\$250 - \$500), Gold (\$750 – \$999) and Eagle (\$1,000 +) being the levels up from the standard Family membership. It was also agreed to raise the standard Family membership to \$40 and include an Eagle car decal (it had been \$30). Lisa Plantamura will look into tax deductible letters for large donors. We are not a not-for-profit entity but the school is. Vote to approve plan. (Keenan/Krause)
- **Spirit Wear** – Members would like to see Spirit Wear sold at some of the Basketball games and be present at our March Social. Looking into items for a drawing at the Social.
- **Fishing** - Putting together a funding request. Other options brought by Members were getting the new Bass Pro Shop to sponsor the team and Maui Jim just announced that they will be using part of their Corporate Donations to go to kids sports.
- **Referendum/Facilities Improvement** – Mr. Peterson will be meeting with the Board next week. Lots of surveying going on. Board approved a spending limit of \$5 million.
