Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Total balance of \$49,513.02. Approximately \$5,700 still to spend after pool lanes and Eagle Mascot. Recent audit cleared.

- Need to decide on tiered membership and any other changes

- Chris Winkel will represent Boosters at Freshman Orientation in January and we will have banner and pamphlets there

Team Rep Reports:

- **Cheerleading** – Upcoming competition in February. Cheerleader cheered at United Center for Boys BB game.
- **Boys Swimming** – Swimming has won both their meets. Some tough competition coming up.
- **Boys Basketball** – All boys teams off to a good start especially the Freshman. Game at United Center on Jan 1st was a really great experience, well attended and lots of fun. Would like Mr. Peterson to look into more opportunities of this sort.
- **Girls Basketball** – Varsity 10-4. Playing really well.

Allocations Committee:

- Swimming lanes approved an order via email vote
- Approved to split cost of new Eagle Mascot costume with Parents Club (approx. \$600). Lisa reported that it should be in for Pack the Place night
- Baseball requested \$280 for new catcher equipment. Committee will look into it and have a recommendation at Feb meeting.
- Mike Massey is stepping down as Allocations Rep and Lisa Mathes has agreed to take his place

New Business:

- **Concessions for Basketball** – Discussion on funding split for Football vs. Basketball duties. Basketball not as much work as Football due to volume and the volunteers for basketball are responsible for opening and closing the stand. New split for teams ordering concessions and managing football are \$2200 and basketball \$800. This year it was decided to give the full \$3000 to Boys Basketball since the representatives from Boys Basketball have taken over basketball concessions due to their football experience with the new system.
- **Social** – Spring Social will be THURSDAY, March 3rd at 7:00 in the DHS Commons. Our original meeting time on Wednesday fell on Ash Wednesday so the vote was to move it one day. Lisa will coordinate and Barrack's will provide a cheesecake bar. A postcard will be sent out to members.
- **Tiered Membership** – Pete will have a plan to propose for the Feb meeting so we can announce our decision at the March social
- **Spirit Wear** – members thought that Spirit Wear should be more visible. Possible framed case with spirit wear display in Commons, have Spirit Wear sales at more events like big home basketball games
- **Fishing** - now an IHSA recognized sport and will be recognized and supported by the Boosters. New Rep for Fishing is Lisa Lavery – welcome Lisa!
