Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Total balance of \$47,456.89. About \$600 left to spend this year on team requests. Wants input for budget next year and adjustments to income so she can come up with a number for how much we can spend on team requests. Looking into a separate account for Capital Campaign funds.

Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- Spring Sports awards night tomorrow as well as the first Athletic Code meeting.
- Other Athletic Code meetings July 7<sup>th</sup> & August 1<sup>st</sup> – make sure attend one!

- 7 – 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Conference & 11- 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Conference
- 5 Place overall in Mid-Illini Conference – down from past but we are in a tough conference
- 2 All State in Boys Track

#### Membership Chair: Meg Angevine

- 95 memberships have come in so far – 5 @ \$1000! Over \$11,500 in memberships have come in, already way up from last year's total of \$7000.
- 8 VIP parking spaces sold already.
- Need “canned” letter on our website for Booster members to print off and give to employers and businesses for tiered membership and larger donations.
- Need to place an order for tiered membership merchandise.
- Dena ordering window decals for each Booster membership – 300 total.

#### Team Rep Reports:

- **Boys Baseball** – Won the Galesburg Tournament; beat Richwoods in Regionals and lost a close one to ND 2-1.
- **Girls Softball** – Currently playing to advance to State; won the Regionals; 22 & 11 overall.
- **Girls Soccer** – Girls 8 & 7 on the season; beat IVC for Senior night; won the Regional Title; Jordan Gunn named to the All-State team; Carolyn Gunn is stepping down from Boosters Rep for Soccer since her daughter has graduated. We will miss you!
- **Girls Track** – Leah Brooks finished 11<sup>th</sup> at State; both F/S & Varsity finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in Conference; placed well at Honor Roll meet.
- **XCountry** – Are having their Picnic on June 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### Allocations Committee:

- Gave check for \$1000 to the Dunlap Special Olympics Athletic Team to use to buy uniforms and equipment. Beverly Taylor and her son were there to talk about the program and how it has grown. Thanked Boosters and the school for their support.
- Softball just put in a request for a pitching machine, Allocations Committee will look at it for funding after budget is approved with next year's money.

#### New Business:

- **Referendum/Facilities Improvement** – Mr. Peterson updated us on the progress despite the rainy weather.
  - **Soccer** – new field has be dug and graded; grass will be planted shortly. Concession stand and parking lot well underway. While the new field is being made ready the soccer teams will play their home games on the new turf on the football field which will be lined for soccer.
  - **Football** – all dirt removed and concrete rim has been poured for turf. Concession stand on south side is underway.
  - **Softball/Baseball** – fence is coming down the new concessions stand/restroom facility is ready for walls. Other improvements to the fields will start as soon as the seasons end.
  - **Tennis** – courts have been demolished and where the area has been graded where the old soccer field used to be. The new ones will be started shortly with an anticipated finish date of August 8<sup>th</sup>.
- **Election of Officers** – No new candidates came forward to run for office so the current officers (Aaron Smith – President; Chris Winkle – VP; Dena Keenan – Secretary; Lisa Plantamura – Treasurer) were reinstated by unanimous vote. (Mangieri/Griebel)

- **Budget** – Lisa will have the budget done in July for final approval. She handed out a preliminary budget for everyone to look over. She will have new line items for Membership expenses, renovation expenses for concessions, corporate sponsorship and capital campaign funds.
- **Capital Campaign** – The Committee (John Noll, Aaron Smith, Mark Radosevic & Mary VanDenAvond) will meet tonight to decide how best to proceed. They will come to Boosters next month with their recommendations.

- Several new Reps have joined but still need a few more. If you don't have a Rep, your team may lose out on Booster funding!!!
