Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- Fall Awards night is Nov 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:30.
- We had 14 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Conference players and 12 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Conference
- Sophomore boys basketball hosting a Thanksgiving tournament.
- Both girls and boys XC qualified for State – first time since 1992!
- 2 Golfers Champions and Leah Brooks XC Conference Champ.

- Nov. 12<sup>th</sup> girls swimming will be competing at Sectionals.

#### Membership Chair: Meg Angevine

- 3 new families
- Golf up to 47%!; Dance from 0 to 20%!; Cheerleading leading at 58%!

#### Team Rep Reports:

- **Girls Tennis** – Season over, 4<sup>th</sup> in Sectionals, two girls went to State and 2 got 1<sup>st</sup> team All-Conference.
- **Football** – 6-4, made play-offs, 2 – 1<sup>st</sup> Team and 4-2<sup>nd</sup> Team.
- **Girls Swimming** – 7 & 2 in dual meets, won Mid-Illini conference for the 4<sup>th</sup> time in 5 years, won 7 out of 12 events, 3 of the fastest times in the area, 8 girls on Honor Roll that are in top 6 in their events. Way to go!
- **Boys Soccer** – 13-9-1, lost to ND in Regional final, lots of honors for Conference and one All-Sectional.
- **X Country** – Really good season, Brooks girls conference champion
- **Volleyball** – Good season, 3 way tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, lost tough match in Regionals
- **Boys Golf** – Team took 2<sup>nd</sup> in Regionals, one went to State
- **Girls Golf** – Lexi advanced to State
- **Dance** – starting to prepare for competitions and indoor basketball routines, having a fundraiser at the Women's Lifestyle Show.
- **Girls BB** – Started Mon, low #'s in upper grades so they have a very young team.

#### Allocations Committee:

- Handed out new Funding Request sheet to look over and approve. Approved. (Gibbons/Mangieri)

#### New Business:

- **Facilities Improvement** – Mr. Peterson updated us on progress.
  - **Soccer** – main field seeded and up, lots of landscaping still to do, covered benches need fixing, new press box approved for new field. Girls soccer will be on the turf in the Spring.
  - **Football** – working on better flow – new sidewalk from visitor side.
  - **Softball/Baseball** – infield has been laid and there are plans for more seating on both fields.
  - Finishing touches are being put on the facilities including clean-up, lights in the parking lot, and landscaping. All work should be complete in the next week.
- **Concessions** – New plan for paying concessions was tabled until next month to take into consideration comments that came up during the month. A certified person needs to be on-hand in order for us to serve hot and non-prepackaged food such as nachos and gondolas. Mr. Peterson looking into a DHS staff person filling that position.
- **State Bound Athletes** – Mentioned that we don't do enough to recognize students who are participating at the State level. Most sports do their own banners or locker decoration for recognition. Talked about getting a banner that says State Bound/Play-off Bound that we can change names to honor all our sports.
