Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- Two XC runners qualified for State.

- Girl's swimming was the team Champion at recent large meet.

Team Rep Comments:

- Cheerleaders are selling bracelets for \$5 and practicing for basketball.

- Volleyball just went out in Regionals. Looking to create a Dunlap travel team using local coaches and practicing at the high school. Trying to cut costs over Bloomington or East Peoria travel team plus give Dunlap girls a chance to play together as a team year-round.
