Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Balance of \$51,946.41. Had actuals from last year to compare our progress. Concession stand gross is at about \$18,000 so far.

Athletic Director's Update: Duane Peterson

- Oct 14 XC conference meet, come cheer them on if you can, they are going for wins in both boys and girls.

- Awarded some post season tournaments – Regional soccer Oct 18, 19 &20 (ND, Richwoods, Galesburg and us) and volleyball Regional(Rock Island, Geneseo, us)
- Girls Tennis Conference will be held this weekend at our facilities but hosted by East Peoria.
- Both boys and girls XC are conference champs.
- Fall Awards night is Tuesday, November 8th.

Membership Chair: Meg Angevine

- Meg handed out new Fall rosters with Booster members marked.
- Suggested we move VIP Parking lot to the middle school right in front of South gate. Easier to manage and easier to get out when the game is over.
- New health rules require teams that are running their own concessions to have a manager. The course is 15 hours and needs to be done within a 3 month period. School looking into options for an employee to be the on-site manager for concessions that would cover all sports. Otherwise it will be up to the individual sports to have a parent take the course.

Team Rep Reports:

- **Girls Tennis** – Varsity 4-2 in conference; F/S is 6-0. Took 2nd at Pekin tournament, 3rd at Galesburg tournament and 8th at Bloomington tournament out of 16 teams. Conference is this weekend and will be played at Dunlap but East Peoria is host. We will run concessions.
- **Football** – Varsity is 4-2 and need to win 2 out of the last 3 remaining games to qualify for playoffs. Freshman are 2-4 and Sophomores are 3 -3.
- **Girls Swimming** – 5-1 in dual meets – only loss to Bloomington; Honor Roll coming out; 3 swimmers have the fastest times in their events and their 200 Medley Relay is also the fastest.
- **Boys Soccer** – Varsity is 9-8-1 and 4-2 in conference. Beat Limestone last night and play Monmouth/Roseville tomorrow and Richwoods on Sat.
- **X Country** – Boys and girls are both currently ranked in the State and we are going for wins in both boys and girls at conference meet on Oct. 14.
- **Volleyball** – Varsity has won 9 in a row. They won the tournament in Moline this past weekend. Varsity plays at 7:00 tomorrow night against Metamore – please come and cheer them on!
- **Boys Golf** – Played last conference match and lost to Pekin. Jake Schneider was first team All-Conference and Matthew Lavery was 2nd team All-Conference. Placed 2nd at Regionals.
- **Girls Golf** – Lexi Hammerton took first at the Conference meet. Really good showing for the girls.
- **Dance** – Girls have been dancing at football games and at the homecoming pep rally. There are gearing up for a big fundraiser. Dance team members will share Rep position.

Allocations Committee:

- No new requests. All old requests have been evaluated and approved.

New Business:

- **Facilities Improvement** – Mr. Peterson updated us on progress.
 - **Soccer** – Field getting straw and seed and some repairs are being done to the parking area.
 - **Football** – New equipment for the concessions stands has been purchased and is being installed as per the health inspection.
 - **Softball/Baseball** – Sod is in and they are cutting the lines.
 - Finishing touches are being put on the facilities. All work should be complete in the next 2 weeks.
- **Concessions** – a new proposal for running and paying teams for concessions was put forward by Aaron Smith. Highlights: Boosters will stock all concession stands, 5% of proceeds go to team

active during concessions, additional 20% will go to teams who run their own concessions, a flat fee will be paid to teams that sign-up to run concessions when their team is not the team active during the concessions. Please see attached document for more details. We will vote on this item at the November meeting.
