Treasurer's Report: Lisa Plantamura

Lisa presented a report showing our actual, a proposed budget, differences and last year's actuals. Lisa had checks for everyone that had submitted expenses for the various projects. Logo sales have been up and they have already needed to reorder. Sales should continue strong through Christmas and then historically taper off. Phyllis motioned to accept report and Ron seconded. Athletic Camera & Accessories:

Football paid for new athletic video camera and accessories for all sports to use to replay game footage for teaching/coaching purposes. Cost was \$723.51. Allocations committee had approved. Ron moved that we accepted the cost and reimburse football, Ed seconded. Motion passed.

- Cheerleaders held a camp/clinic for elementary girls. It was very well attended and raised a lot of money.

Money Requests:

Girl's softball wants a backstop similar to the one for baseball. District paid for baseball backstop. Sound system also in need of an overhaul. Mr. Peterson suggested Coach Olson contact Al Shrader.

Membership/Donations:

Ron Murphy reported that only 59% of families with a student in a fall sport are Booster members. He suggested that a letter be sent out to all families with students in sports that are not members outlining what we do and some of the items we have funded. He suggested we point out that Dunlap does not charge to participate in athletics like other schools. Kris McClelland will write the initial draft. Suggestions were also made to have the letter and membership forms available at the Fall Athletic Night in November.

Other Business:

- Pete, Tom Welsh and Duane Peterson took Superintendent Jay Marino around our area to see different sport facilities. They are talking about a \$2.5 - \$3M dollar infusion into the high school athletics programs for new facilities and facilities improvements
- Tennis court improvements came in under budget at \$1,332.39. The concrete slab still needs to be poured for the shed. That should be done shortly if the weather cooperates.
