- Well underway with Fall activities.
- Sept 17th volleyball tournament and a large XCcountry meet.

- Awarded some post season tournaments – Regional soccer and volleyball and possibility of Regional XC.
- Offered Sectional tennis for boys.
- Spring soccer currently planned on turf, earliest we will play on new soccer field is next fall.

Membership Chair: Meg Angevine

- All tiered membership perks will be here on Friday.
- Meg handed out Fall rosters with Booster members marked. Boys Soccer and Cheerleading have the highest membership.
- Decided our own mailing did not get the desired results and we will again send our information out with the rest of the Dunlap information. We need to have our membership form done early!

Team Rep Reports:

- **Cheerleading** – Looking to get 100% participation.
- **Girls Tennis** – 1st home match last week, took second out of 8 schools at Invite, JV 4-0..
- **Football** – Varsity is 2-0; tough line-up coming; Soph. is 2-0 and Fresh is 1-1. Notre Dame opted out of our contract and we will play Genessee next year.
- **Girls Swimming** – 2nd dual meet; beat Galesburg – big win!; beat Peoria Central; Kaylie Noll broke and 18 year old record in 500 free.
- **Boys Soccer** – Varsity is 3-2-1 with several starters injured; JV won their home tournament.
- **X Country** – At Galesburg meet had 3 medal placers; 5th overall; Boys were 2nd and are currently ranked 14th in the State.
- **Volleyball** – 1-1 currently.
- **Boys Golf** – 2-2; 3rd at Monmouth; Jake Schneider was 4th overall and we had 2 in the top 10.
- **Dance** – last week the girls got a coach! Things are moving forward!

Allocations Committee:

- Leslie Lavery elected new member of committee to replace Sue Phipps.

New Business:

- **Referendum/Facilities Improvement** – Mr. Peterson updated us on progress.
 - **Soccer** – Concession stand almost complete; field will be seeded soon and the irrigation is almost done.
 - **Football** – Everyone really happy with the turf; concession stand will be functional next week.
 - **Softball/Baseball** – Concession stand almost complete; still need electrical for scoreboards; waiting to put in new infield.
 - **Tennis** - Courts are ready and grass has been planted.
 - **Ring Road** is going in and all new parking is almost complete. Would like to have it all done by first home football game.
 - **Weight Equipment** still not in yet.
 - Sept. 30 is completion date.
 - Black fencing will go around stadium.
- **Website** is up to date. Need new membership information.
- **50/50 & VIP Parking** – We have our license and Chris Winkel will run it until we find a coordinator. A sophomore parent has agreed to run VIP Parking and will have people there at 4:45 on game days.
- **Concessions** – We are bumping up the money to work concessions for football because of the number of volunteers required to run two stands - \$300. Still working on getting information to

make a good decision on how to handle teams who use the concession stands for their own sports like soccer. Want fair, across the board rules and payments.
