1. Club Sign Ups – September 4th (dues in by September 18th)

--Sit out during lunches for sign ups. In previous years, they have signed up first and collected money later. They recommend we make people pay as they sign up. Also, the price of dues will be \$15

--Run an announcement about last chance sign ups September 18th through the 21st

--September 18th-23rd (Build Float)

--September 18th (Take Pictures and Kiss Cards)

4. Dessert Theatre—November 8th–November 11th (Possible Dates of the show)

5. Data Match—Late December (The forms and envelopes will be mailed to Ms. Harwood and put in her mailbox)

--Go around to all homerooms and make sure they are filled out. Mail them back in early February so you can get them by Valentine's Day.

--Have Members sign up sometime in the end of January to sit at the lunch tables. GET THAT DONE IN ADVANCE!!!

PROM FASHION SHOW

6. Prom Fashion Show—End of February, Early March (Start planning, the key is to start AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE)

--Early March—Find 15 girls and 15 guys (either through sign ups, and if not enough, pick some)
 1. Girls are usually picked going by the scale most involved to whoever paid the most. The girls should be in the club to be involved. For guys, it might be different. Use guys that are in the club first, and then find guys that want to be in it. Approve with Mrs. Heffner and Ms. Harwood of any one not in the club in order to avoid problems
 - Late March—Start calling places for dresses, tuxs, and hair.
 2. Seno—Used for tuxs and is very cooperative
 3. Enchanted Florist—Used for flower arrangement for the last 4 years, call early!
 4. Bergners—MAKE SURE TO CALL EARLY! Last year they didn't accept us because we called too late.
 5. Bella Me Boutique—Girl's Dresses

6. Cache—Girl's Dresses
7. Reflections—Girl's hair

--Set up a committee for decorations and get them started. Have their main ideas planned by early April so they can start decorating as soon as the auditorium is open.

ii. First week of April—Get music from the couples of the songs they want to walk to and make a final draft of the CD.

--Week of the show—Have 2 or 3 walkthroughs so everyone knows what and where they are supposed to be going/doing.

--Make sure decorations get up!

--Decide cost for admission. Last year they did \$0.50.

--Call places for donations. 2 years ago reflections gave out free tans and tanning lotions.

END OF THE YEAR TRIP

7. End of the Year Trip—It will be much easier if one committee is designated to the fashion show, and one committee is designated to the end of the year trip, because planning happens at the exact same time.

START PLANNING EARLY!

--Have final plans made BEFORE March, that way calling and travel needs will be easy to figure out.

--Search Chicago and find things to do that would have to do with the club. In previous years, fashion shows, schools, and museums have been the way they've chosen to go.

--Call Peoria Charter Co. EARLY to reserve a bus. The price is about \$790 for a 49 passenger bus.

--Make plans and show the receipts to the office. The district office will reimburse us for \$250 of our bill. Talk to Mr. Mangers about it.

--In previous years, cost for the trip as been around \$25. If we make it higher people might not want to pay it.
