- Physical and Dental exam records can be dated up to one (1) year prior to beginning of school year

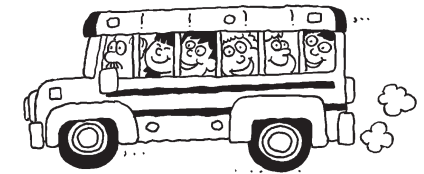

Is your child ready for school*?

* These are the minimum requirements to be in compliance with the rules for school entry. The Department of Public Health and your Doctor may recommend additional immunizations and exams for your child.

If your child is entering Preschool he/she will need _____

- a physical exam
- 4 DTaP shots (*Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis*)
- 3 Polio shots
- 1 HIB shot (*Meningitis*) (1 or more doses)
- 1 MMR shot (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella*)
- 3 Hepatitis B shots
- 1 Varicella (*Chicken Pox*) or proof of having had the disease
- TB screening
- Lead screening
(Blood test **STRONGLY** recommended.)

If your child is entering Kindergarten he/she will need _____

- a physical exam
- an eye exam
- a dental exam
- DTaP booster (*Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis*)
- Polio booster
- MMR shot (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella*)
- Varicella (*Chicken Pox*) or proof of having had the disease
- Lead screening
(Blood test **STRONGLY** recommended.)

If your child is entering 2nd or 6th Grade he/she will need a dental exam.

If your child is entering 6th or 9th Grade he/she will need* _____

- a physical exam
 - Hepatitis B shots (*required by 5th grade*)
 - Tetanus/Diphtheria (*Td or Tdap*) recommended at age 11-12 (proof required at 9th grade)
- * **Other immunizations recommended at age 11-12: Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine and for girls, HPV vaccine.**

Head Start & Early Head Start _____

If your child is going into Head Start, he/she will need to have a physical exam done within six (6) months of starting school, a dental exam within one year, TB skin test results done within the past year or a waiver from physician or Health Department, immunizations, including Hepatitis B and Varicella, date and results of one lead blood test, date and results of a hemoglobin or hematocrit blood test.
