Parental Involvement

In order to assure collaborative relationships between students' families and the Board of Education and District personnel, and to enable parent(s)/guardian(s) to become active partners in their children's education, the Superintendent shall:

1. Keep parent(s)/guardian(s) thoroughly informed about their child's school and education.
2. Encourage parent(s)/guardian(s) to be involved in their child's school and education.
3. Establish effective two-way communication between parent(s)/guardian(s) and the Board of Education and District personnel.
4. Seek input from parent(s)/guardian(s) on significant school-related issues.
5. Inform parents/guardians on how they can assist their children's learning.

The Superintendent shall periodically report to the Board of Education on the implementation of this policy.
